Prefix	Definition	Related Words
sub-	<i>below/under</i>	subway (noun) – an underground electric railroad, usually in a large city
com-	<i>with/together</i>	companion (noun) – a person who is frequently in the company of, associates with, or accompanies another
pro-	<i>for/forward/in favor of</i>	propel (verb) – to drive, or cause to move, forward or onward
en-	<i>causing something to happen</i>	enforce (verb) – to put or keep in force
de-	<i>to take away</i>	defrost (verb) – to remove the <u>frost</u> or ice from
